Main Welfare & Development Activities of the Society:

Children's Work at Ashray Bhavan – We provide wholistic care and development to the children living in Orphanage. The Event was started on 14th Nov 2014 with the goal of benefitting maximum strengths in the Punjab state. We have started this program with 15 children's and now approx 200 Children's are getting benefit of our initiation. We are continue running this in our district which is mohali and will expand it to the state level so that maximum could be benefitted. We are running this project on our own expenditure so that what we are getting from society could be pay back to them.

Community Education and Development

In partnership with like minded agencies we encourage needy people in remote areas to enhance literacy, and education for a better life. We have initiated this programme on 10th Oct 2014 in Ballopur Village of Derabassi Tehsil in Mohali District with the students of age group 8-14. In our first initiation approx 20 children's joined us. We are continue running this in Ballopur with expansion of this programme in some other villages such as Malakpur and Handesra and in coming year we are planning to expand it at tehsil level so that literacy percentage of the state can be increase. Whole Expenditure of Study material as well as the salary of the trainer or teacher is spent by the society.



Medical Relief

- We Conduct eye camps and cataract surgeries free of cost for villagers, and referring very poor and needy patients to hospitals and institutions.
- We have organise this event on 25th Dec 2014 on the eve of Christmas and approx 90 persons been benefitted through this medical relief camp and in coming years we are also going to organise this on larger scale so that maximum persons can be benefitted.
- We also hold free dental camps through partnership with hospitals.
- In partnership with Divya Sikshan Sansthan Trust we conduct homeo clinics for the benefit of villagers around in mohali District.

Social Outreach

- We conduct orientation programmes to create awareness about HIV on 27th Dec 2014. We have called eminent doctors from PGI Chandigarh who have cleared the doubts and the misconception spreading out in the society about the HIV. Approx 35 persons have participated in this event and we have planned to do such type of awareness camp time to time so that society could be aware of these disease.
- Encourage needy widows to start sewing centres to earn a living by giving free sewing machines. We have distributed these sewing machines on 1st Jan 2015 to 10 widows who belongs to Malakpur Village.
- Micro finance support to needy villagers to set up small business. In this programme we are short listing some proposals so that needy could be benefitted



- **English Teaching to Unemployed students**

We run language learning centre for villagers of Ballopur to learn English at the centre in Ballopur. Many thousand have availed this opportunity and have completed the courses offered by us. We have initiated(opened) this centre on 20th October 2014 to heal the phobia of English learning amongst the rural population. We are still running this project on our own expenditure in Ballopur and planning to open other Centre in Kharar.
