Main Welfare & Development Activities of the Society:

1. Livelihood Promotion, SHG & Income Generation Programme:

UNIVERSAL EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY with the support of local Volunteers and Students of Universal Group of Institutions started Empowerment of poor women SHG program in 2013. The first SHG formed with the financial help of UES is on 9th Feb 2015 comprising of 10 peoples. It covered 02 Panchayats of Mohali district with an aim to increase the participation of poor and marginalized women livelihood local Entitlements reduce violence against women, livelihood promotion, ensure enforcement of policies and laws to women's rights and establishing linkages with government and other institutions for the effective realization of anti-poverty programs. Under the program, training of SHG women, formation of SHGs, Linkages and strengthen of SHG, awareness generation through mixed media activities and organization of workshops and seminars were undertaken. These programs have helped positively in sensitization of the target group as well as the other stakeholders towards the women's issues and their socio-economic rights.

2. Promotion of Science & Technology:

"The objective of the program is to arouse the latent curiosity of students and rural youth through hands-on science education. The society wants to enable them to become innovator, solution-seekers and problem-solvers. To achieve this we have established many pilot plants at our college campus as well as in adopted villages pertaining to low cost technology for farmers, energy substitutes and alternatives, medicinal plants, science laboratories and exhibitions etc. We organise technical fest each year in month of November where thousands of students from different schools and colleges participate and demonstrate their ideas through model projects.

3. Seminars & Workshops:

It is our constant endeavour to take learning beyond the confines of a classroom and make it an enjoyable experience for our students as well as the community also. Consequently, wide arrays of workshops are regularly organized that not only help to give a hands-on experience but also motivate and inspire the learners to be worthy human beings. A seminar on career opportunities with a special focus on careers for students with rural background and disabilities was organized on 23rd September 2015.





NSS Activities:



In accordance with the NSS motto, symbol, and its significance an effective presentation was delivered on 24th September 2015, in which the students were briefed about the NSS activities and community programmes that can be conducted at college and university level. Basic objective is to establish a meaningful linkage between the campus and the community. Through this initiative the students got a better understanding of the work to be effectively carried by them.

5. Entrepreneurship Development Programs:

To bring about awareness about entrepreneurship skills a 15 days training programme was organized for students free of cost on 15th July 2015 which ended on 29th July 2015 . The Entrepreneurship Skill-Training Workshop was a practical and intensive 15 days program which trained the participants on a process for developing and scaling ideas. The program consisted of an ideas framework that helped participants, get ideas, validate them, develop them and test them in a real world environment. The programme was aimed at inspiring and providing education and critical skills for young entrepreneurs and designed to give prospective entrepreneurs the skills and resources they need to address community issues and create sustainable enterprises. These programs include technology to market accelerators, business plan competitions, ideation workshops, technology tools, entrepreneurship curricula to help students build entrepreneurship skills. The e-learning course was based on the fundamentals of entrepreneurship and education on basic technology tools that can be used to empower businesses. The program had 40 hours of content and gave entrepreneurship education to commercialize and scale businesses.

After successful completion of the programme the students made a final presentation with the use of technology for entrepreneurship. 25 students belonging to local villages successfully completed the training programme



6. Minority Welfare & Development Program:

A large number of minority students particularly of Muslim students are not aware of benefit schemes of minorities especially that of Muslims announced either by Central Government or State Governments such as Prime Minister 15 programme. Largest part of Muslims is apparently seen not in the habit of reading newspapers especially the announcements pertaining to educational benefits and development schemes by way of scholarships. Further great many students are under impression that career such as engineering, medical and business management alone would upraise their future, payback fittingly. Therefore, there is heavy rush and competition, and institutions offering such courses are costly. Shockingly this year a number of students have committed suicides due to disappointment, distress, and depression arising from magnitude of competition and gravity of course syllabi. Our use to make the people of minority community aware of the Government schemes and planning for

the people. We have Organise this event on 4th August 2015 in Ballopur Village where approx 100 students from local community belonging to minority participated in it.

7. Rural development programs- Training on Improved Method of Pulse Production:

Training programmes on improved method of pulse production have been imparted to the small and marginal farmers in Mohali District on 18th August 2015 . Dissemination and adoption of Pulse production technology a vast scope for the upliftment of rural poor people. The society proposed to expand the area coverage of pulses in the district Mohali itself by encouraging farmers without affecting there main cereal crops. The whole expenditure was borrowed by the Universal Educational Society



8. Tribal welfare & Development programs:

There are cases to show that the tribes are denied their right to food. The children of tribal community do not have access to the right to education and right to a midday meal at the school since the teachers do not allow them to eat at the school for the fear that the children will pollute the utensils. Tribal children cannot have access to the facilities provided from the Anganwadi Centre (AC; child care centre) under the Integrated Child Development System as the tribal women do not have any priority to be employed as a worker for the centre. The society has taken the issues to the authorities as well as do its best to help tribal children enrol in proper schools and gets basic amenities of livelihood without any discrimination. The society has started to provide free coaching to these children if they require to improve their skill and employability. Free coaching to the students of tribal community is been providing by the students and teachers of Universal Group of Institution free of Cost. This Coaching Centre is been running in the premises of Universal Group of Institution where approx 60 Students are getting benefit of our programme. This Programme is running continuously and we are planning to implement this in kharar district also.



9. Promotion of health services:

***PULSE POLIO PROGRAMME:**

UNIVERSAL EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY undertook Pulse Polio Programme in the Mohali District of Punjab. An orientation and training programme was organized for the students participating in the immunization campaign. The Program was being conducted on a continuous basis throughout the year. Student volunteers are placed at the centre to help the Government initiatives. They administered polio drops to the children of Mohali District on the stipulated dates. In the following weeks the students conducted door to-door visit and administered polio drops to children.

FREE EYE CHECK-UP CAMP:

The N.S.S. students actively volunteered for the Free Eye Check-up Camp, Free Spectacles distribution and Free Cataract Operation Camp organized by the UNIVERSAL EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY at the Universal Group Of Institutions on 20th October 2015 . The volunteers assisted in registration of the community who visited the camp. They helped in distribution of free spectacles, medicines and awareness programmes. Over 300 people visited the camp which was conducted from 8.30 a.m. to 2.30 p.m.



10. Women Empowerment & Welfare :

The objective of this programme is to make the women know of their rights and laws enabling them earn their livelihood, fight for their rights and requirements. Women constitute the very backbone of the family. Women have to play multiple roles: a mother, a wife and a host of other roles simultaneously. Every family is dependent on the woman, who is the lady of the house. Children look up to their mother for guidance on social, cultural, educational and religious values. The husband depends on the woman for every aspect of the family life. Empowering women will lead to a well-balanced family structure, which is vital for proper growth of the SOCIETY. In this front we are organizing Mahila Mandals and Mahila Panchayats in these villages where our women volunteers discuss the issues and try to settle the matter immediately with the consent of family members. we organize these types of activity on 8th March of Every Year.





11. Programs for senior citizens, disadvantages and differently abled people :

The surveys on lives of senior citizens, disadvantages and differently abled people it was found that malnutrition is one of the most prevalent illnesses that threaten the health of the Elders of Punjab. The Elderly routinely suffer from hunger and nutrition related illnesses. UNIVERSAL EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY is dedicated to spread the message among people of Punjab; a sense of partnership and hope by motivating children and youth to look after well their parents. With the objective of improving the quality of life of people with the concerned disabilities we are organising free medical check up camps, helping them procure artificial limbs, hearing aids, tricycles and other preventive and curative devices. Our social workers use to mix up with them and motivating them to feel like an ordinary human being like others. We are mobilising business houses to provide training and employment opportunities for them so as to make them independent and live a graceful life.



12. Consumer welfare & Awareness Programme:

In spite of the various initiatives undertaken by the Government to educate and promote welfare to the consumers, the analysis of the primary data collected from 1200 undergraduates' s t u d e n t s from six different colleges located in three different talukas of Mohali District revealed that the level of consumer awareness is limited.

The society launched an awareness program to make the public aware of their rights as a consumer. To achieve this, the society implemented the following program in the District of Mohali:

- Awareness Drive-All over the Colony and near by Areas, Door To Door and in masses, schools and other weekly market places.
- Audio-Visual Presentations At Different Shopping Complexes and weekly markets
- Demonstration Of home level detection of adulterated goods At different public places.

Objectives

- To ensure maximum participation of community people in this drive and motivate them to fight for their genuine rights as a consumer.
- To sensitize the traders and business community towards a fair consumer and trader relationship.
- To make the people aware of their rights as a consumer while doing purchasing and availing services from any professional.
- To suggest the possible ways of sorting out problems
- To demonstrate the practical ways of avoiding cheating by conducting road shows and skits.





13. Educational Programs, Free Coaching & Computer Literacy Campaign:

NON-FORMAL EDUCATION:

Though many of govt. schemes support literacy campaign but still there are hundreds of drop out children who have stopped going and attending schools due to one reason or other. We are identifying them and arranging for imparting them reading and writing skill. The aim of this school is to provide education to the children who are not in a position to attend any formal school and to help them grow into responsible adults and to encourage them becoming independent.

There are several children of poor families who are leftover on the streets and nobody take care of their health. Some of these children tend to look to the other side of life i.e. they get involved in various criminal activities and end up as anti-social elements. The society is running a free coaching center and computer institute for the poor children. In which basics of computer operations and hardware assembling is being taught.





14. Training and placement cell:

The placement Cell acts as a catalyst by focusing on activities that enhance the students' career development and employability. Moreover, it fosters activities that aim to empower students to make well thought out career choices. The college has access to a wide spectrum of industries to enable it to set new standard in the field of engineering education. The necessary internship and pre-placement opportunity is provided to the students for them to get easily placed during their dissertation period itself. The industry- college interface fostered at the college is what gives the college a class of its own.
